

## **Privacy Policy for International Council of Multiple Birth Organisation Inc.**

At International Council of Multiple Birth Organisations (ICOMBO), [www.icombo.org](http://www.icombo.org), one of our priorities is the privacy of our visitors. This Privacy Policy contains the types of information that is collected and recorded by ICOMBO and explains how we use and store that information.

This policy applies only to our online activities and is valid for visitors to our website with regards to the information that we collect in ICOMBO website. It is not applicable to any information collected offline or via channels other than this website.

### **Information we collect**

The personal information that you are asked to provide, and the reasons why you are asked to provide it, will be made clear to you at the point we ask you to provide your personal information.

### **How we use your information**

We use the information we collect in various ways, including to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain our website
- Improve, personalise, and expand our website
- Understand and analyse how you use our website
- Develop new features, and functionality
- Communicate with you, including for customer service, and for marketing and promotional purposes
- Send you emails
- Find and prevent fraud

### **Log Files**

ICOMBO follows a standard procedure of using log files. These files log visitors when they visit websites. All hosting companies do this and are part of hosting services' analytics. The information collected by log files include internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, Internet Service Provider (ISP), date and time stamp, referring/exit pages, and possibly the number of clicks. These are not linked to any information that is personally identifiable. The purpose of the information is for analysing trends, administering the site, tracking users' movement on the website, and gathering demographic information.

## **Cookies and Web Beacons**

Like any other website, ICOMBO uses 'cookies'. These cookies are used to store information including visitors' preferences, and the pages on the website that the visitor accessed or visited. The information is used to optimise the users' experience by customising our web page content based on visitors' browser type and/or other information.

## **Third-Party Privacy Policies**

ICOMBO's Privacy Policy does not apply to other websites. Thus, we are advising you to consult the respective Privacy Policies of these third-party servers for more detailed information. It may include their practices and instructions about how to opt-out of certain options.

You can choose to disable cookies through your individual browser options. More detailed information about cookie management with specific web browsers can be found at the browsers' respective websites.

## **California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) Privacy Policy**

Under the CCPA, among other rights, California consumers have the right to request that:

- a business that collects a consumer's personal data disclose the categories and specific pieces of personal data that a business has collected about consumers;
- a business delete any personal data about the consumer that a business has collected;
- a business that sells a consumer's personal data, not sell the consumer's personal data.

## **General Data Protection Right (GDPR) Privacy Policy**

Every user is entitled to the following rights:

- access – the right to request copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- rectification – the right to request that we correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request that we complete the information you believe is incomplete.
- erasure – the right to request that we erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- restrict processing – the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- object to processing – the right to object to our processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- data portability – the right to request that we transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you. If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please contact us.

### **Children's Information**

ICOMBO does not knowingly collect any Personal Identifiable Information from children under the age of 13. If you think that your child provided this kind of information on our website, we strongly encourage you to contact us immediately and we will do our best efforts to promptly remove such information from our records. We encourage parents and guardians to observe, participate in, and/or monitor and guide their online activity.
